The tournament was well supported, with teams and players coming from far and wide to play for the prestigious club trophies in the Mackay Cup (A Grade), Alison Cup (B Grade) and Skene Cup (C Grade).

An impressive line-up of Australian Stock Horses took to the field in all three Grades, and Chairman, Joy Poole OAM had the tough but enjoyable task of judging the award for Best Performing Australian Stock Horse. Peter Haydon of Blandford, New South Wales was delighted to take home the prize on four year brown mare HAYDON EVE (MURRABONG VICTORY/HAYDON EVETTE). Peter is full of praise for his homebred mare, and is pleased that she is turning out a complete and balanced mare to play. 'She is very easy to play on a loose rein but has good handle and run,' said Peter.

Progeny of MURRABONG VICTORY are playing overseas in Argentina and England, with many in Australia performing at top level in both polo and polocrosse. Peter played for the Bloomfield Team in the Alison Cup B Grade, also winning Best Team with HAYDON EVE and HAYDON FINCH.

Special mention also goes to Marty Leacy in the Wirragulla A team, who played Susan Lock's mare DYNAMIC ROULETTE (STAR BRIGADOON - HSH/CHALLABAR JALENE) in the fourth chukka of the Mackay Cup A Grade final.
